

TEWA invests in new Inliner

In April 2008, a new Inliner of the Type “Simca SDS” was put into operation by the Austrian family business TEWA GmbH, based in Feldkirchen. The new plant has a maximum working width of 2.800 mm. The Inliner prints, creases, slits, die cuts, folds and bundles the corrugated cardboard cuts with a maximum production rate of up to 13.000 cartons per hour. All current sorts of corrugated board can be processed and cartons with FEFCO Codes 0201, 0409, 0411, 0412, 0452 and 0453 can be produced. The plant is equipped with servo drive, which enhances high dimension accuracy in printing (2 colours), creasing, slitting and die cutting. The enterprise, founded in 1920, employs 85 people and annually produces about 30 million square metres of corrugated cardboard (B-, C-, E- waves and their combinations). These are processed mainly into regular slotted and die cut boxes as well as displays.
